Certain Forest Products are regulated under the Sudden Oak Death Quarantine and cannot be moved out of the Quarantine Area except under a Compliance Agreement (permit) with the County Agricultural Commissioner.

Regulated (quarantined) articles include the following:

Firewood, Logs, Bark, Sawdust, and Chipped Green Waste

of the following species:

Tanoak

Black Oak

Canyon Live Oak

Christmas Trees, Foliage, Greenery, and Host Wreaths

of the following species:

The above listed species above *plus*

Douglas-fir

Redwood

Manzanita

Madrone

California Buckeye

Bigleaf Maple

Rhododendron

and

Azalea

California Bay Laurel

Other plant species are regulated under the Quarantine but are too numerous to be listed here.
